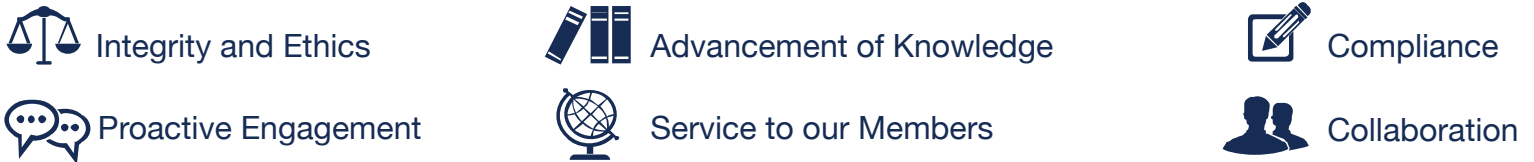

The National Association of Professional Background Screeners (NAPBS) was founded in 2003 to advance excellence in the screening profession by advocating for the interests of employment and tenant background screening companies and by establishing and promoting the highest level of ethics and performance standards for the profession. NAPBS currently represents more than 900 member companies around the globe, ranging from Fortune 100 companies to small local businesses that conduct millions of employment and tenant background checks each year as part of the hiring and leasing process. NAPBS' core members are defined as "consumer reporting agencies" (CRAs) pursuant to the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA) and are regulated by both the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) and Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB).

WE HELP PROTECT CONSUMERS

Background checks are only conducted with the consumer's written consent. Further, consumers are also protected by state consumer protection and privacy laws. Professional screening companies must follow the FCRA, which was drafted as a consumer-protection body of law. Its intent, importantly, is to protect consumers who are the subject of consumer reports or background checks. FCRA compliance is crucial for both professional screening companies as well as their clients, including employers, both of whom have distinct responsibilities under the FCRA. Consumers have a right under the FCRA to challenge the information in a background check in a well-defined dispute resolution process, at no cost to the consumer. In addition to the FCRA, NAPBS members are subject to strict regulations under the Fair and Accurate Credit Transactions Act of 2003 and are trained to properly handle sensitive information including personally identifiable information.

ACCREDITATION

NAPBS offers an accreditation program for CRAs in the U.S. Governed by a strict and thorough set of professional standards of specified requirements and measurements called the Background Screening Agency Accreditation Program (BSAAP), firms must demonstrate compliance in six critical areas during a desk and on-site audit to achieve accreditation. The BSAAP has become a widely recognized seal of achievement that advances professionalism in the employment screening industry through the promotion of best practices, awareness of legal compliance, and development of standards that protect consumers.

INDIVIDUAL CERTIFICATION

The NAPBS individual FCRA Certification program consists of Basic and Advanced Certifications for individuals. The FCRA Basic Certification Program provides a basic knowledge of FCRA regulations. Upon completion of the FCRA Basic Certification Program, individuals may progress to FCRA Advanced Certification which focuses on complex and cutting-edge FCRA compliance issues and includes a series of seminars and/or webinars followed by a written exam.
